Getting to Somerset House

There are four entrances into Somerset House: The Strand, Lancaster Place, River Terrace, and Victoria Embankment. All are currently open.

This is The Strand entrance of Somerset House

You can enter Somerset House through any of the three archways that face onto The Strand. Once you enter you will then be facing the Courtyard.

Arrival to Seamen's Hall



This is the upper terrace of Somerset House

The Upgrade Yourself Takeover: Earth Day event is in Seamen's Hall, and can be accessed from both East and West sides of the upper terrace into The Edmond J. Safra Fountain Court. (Circled in the colour black)

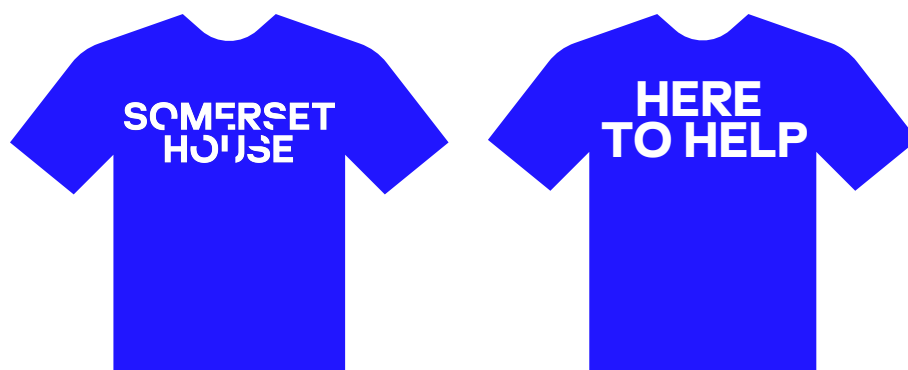


This is The Edmond J. Safra Fountain Court.

Once you enter the courtyard there are two entrances to Seamen's Hall from the courtyard. The main entrance is circled in the colour black. The secondary, the Stamp Office door, is a step-free entrance and is circled in white.

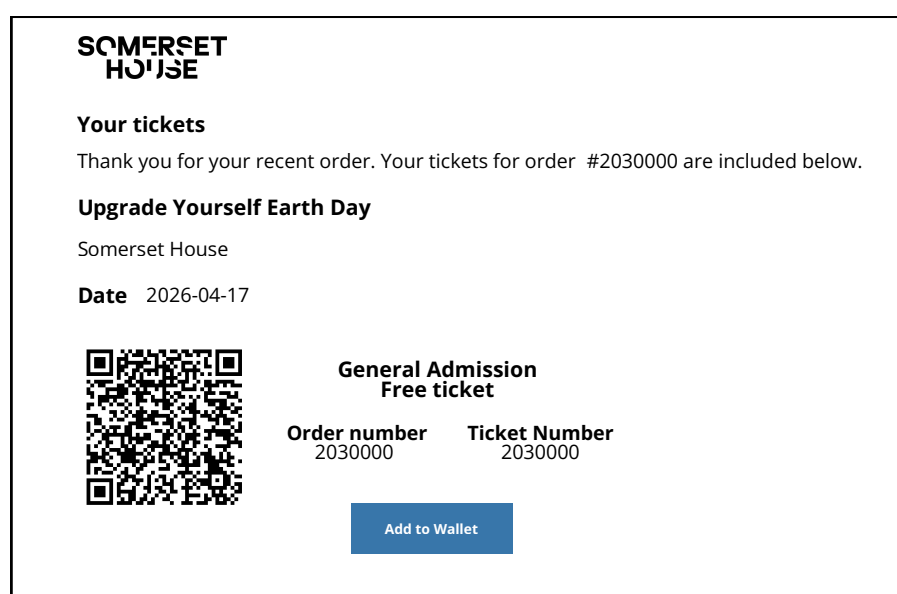
Before entering Seamen's Hall, you will be greeted by our friendly Visitor Experience team.

They wear blue t-shirts with 'Somerset House' in the colour white in the front of the t-shirt and 'Here to Help' on the back (pictured below)



A member of our Visitor Experience team will scan your ticket, give you a wristband, information about the event and directions into Seamen's Hall.

There are three short steps before the entrance to the door.



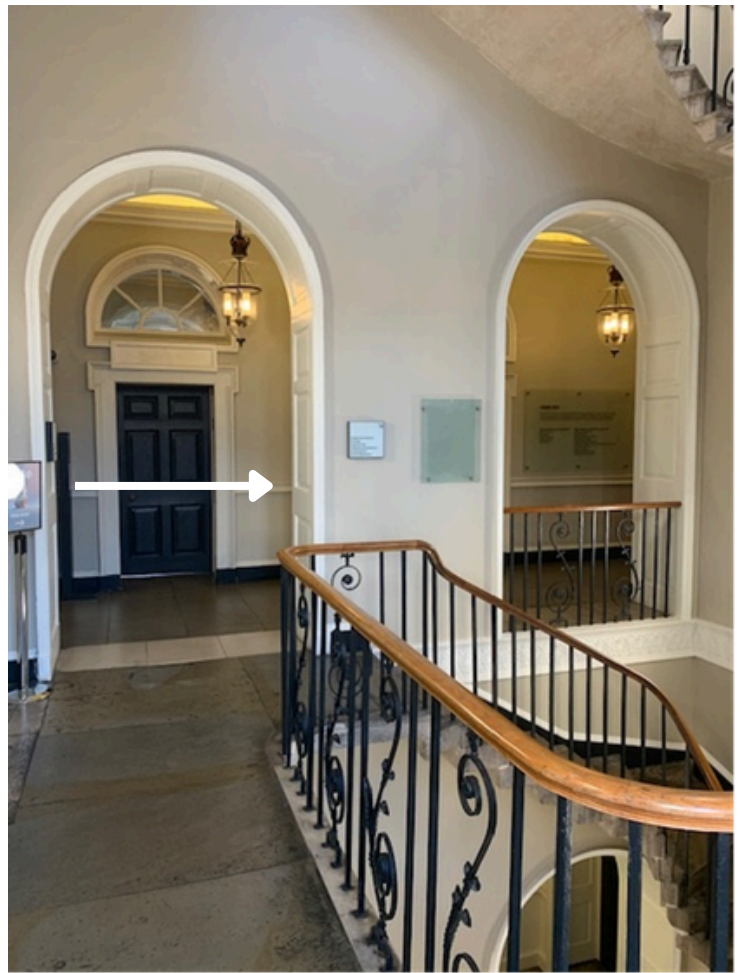
This is Stamp Office door, the step-free entrance to Seamen's Hall
